Innovative Grant Awards and Achievements

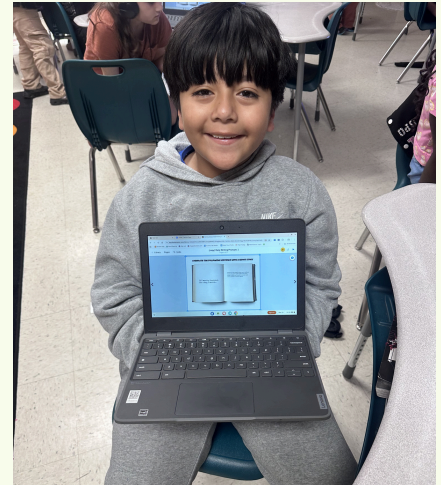


2025-2026 GRANTS AWARDED

Between September 2025 and March 2026, teachers submitted 26 grant applications to the foundation, totaling \$93,703 in requests. So far this school year (2025-2026), we have awarded \$65,927—and there's still one month left! Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors and community contributions, the foundation has awarded over \$563,000 since 2013.

Book Creator

This grant will allow students to use Book Creator to strengthen literacy, creativity, and digital skill by creating and publishing their own learning artifacts. Students will engage more deeply with content while demonstrating understanding in multiple formats. Outcomes will be evaluated by reviewing completed student projects and digital books using teacher created rubrics to measure understanding, creativity, and skill development. In a recent daily writing activity, students responded to the prompt, "If I were President for a day, I would..." After writing their thoughts, they enjoyed adding pictures to illustrate their ideas and share their creativity.



Think Big. Print BIGGER.

Our Printing & Imaging/Graphic Design/Digital Media/Entrepreneurship classes continue to expand the possibilities with this grant! This grant will provide hands-on experience with industry-standard design and printing tools for students in digital arts and entrepreneurship courses. While not all students will directly use the printer, the products it creates, such as posters, banners, and materials for school projects, and the Treasure Trove student store, will benefit the entire student body. This project supports creative, technical, and professional growth while extending its impact across the school and local community. Once students are familiar with the equipment, the service will expand to community members, providing real-world business and marketing experience through the Treasure Trove student store.
